**Day 1- Saturday 9 August 2025**



Home pick up and transfer to Brisbane International Airport. Check in at the airport is a minimum of 2 ½ hours prior to flight departure. Our flight is scheduled to depart Brisbane at 11-35 a.m., arriving Norfolk Island at 2-45 p.m. On arrival we will be met and transferred to the South Pacific Resort Hotel. After settling into your room, perhaps take a leisurely walk to the village and get acquainted with your surroundings and grab a coffee. The South Pacific Resort Hotel will be our host for a 2 course dinner tonight at 5-30 p.m. After dinner we travel to the former convict settlement of Kingston. The stillness and stars are just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788. With the dramatic use of real-life sound, together with theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours take us through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era. After a big first day we return to the South Pacific Resort Hotel.

## Day 2 – Sunday 10 August 2025

After breakfast we head out on our ½ day island tour visiting some of Norfolk's key historical areas including Kingston, Cascade and Longridge. This is our chance to learn about the fascinating history of Norfolk Island. See the famous convict buildings and hear the stories told in full commentary by our local guide. The views from lookouts, overlooking the island's beautiful beaches, are breathtaking. Other highlights include the renowned Melanesian Chapel. Morning tea will be served on this tour. Relax with

free time this afternoon. Experience a fun evening of murder, mystery, and mayhem on the Norfolk Island Murder Mystery Dinner. Enjoy a 3-course meal and interact with true characters from the island's past, including the Commandant, Clergyman, and Convicts. Everyone plays a character to assist in solving the murder. Don't forget to bring your reading glasses to take notes.

## Day 3 – Monday 11 August 2025

Today we join a descendant of the Bounty Mutineers on a 3 hour tour to points of Norfolk, accessible only by 4WD. This 'back and beyond' tour takes you through

private properties and the national park which features spectacular scenery, native flora and bird life. Morning tea will be served at an island home. Note – depending on group size, half of our group will travel on 4WD tour in the morning, while the other half will participate on the tour in the afternoon. Don't worry it will not be a rough race through the scrub! Drivers are conscientious and knowledgeable. Vehicles are comfortable modern 4WD's. Either our morning or afternoon will be free. This will be a perfect time to visit Burnt Pine Village for lunch in one of the local cafes or clubs and do a spot of shopping.





Dinner (2 course) this evening is at Hilli's Restaurant. 'Hilli' is a Norfolk Island expression meaning "disinclined to exertion, relax, take it easy, and unwind". Sounds perfect!

### Day 4 – Tuesday 12 August 2025

Join Pinetree Tours on an in-depth convict settlement tour. Visit the historic Georgian settlement of Kingston, walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones. Our morning tour host will walk us through the ruins of the New Goal. On this tour we will also visit the Pier Store, the Boat Shed and the Crank Mill.

The scenery is amazing. If you prefer not to participate on either walk, a coach will be provided to take you to the breakfast picnic area. Free time for balance of morning. Experience the culture of Norfolk's

forebears on our afternoon outing. From mutineer ancestors and their Tahitian wives comes the arts of wood craft, weaving, cooking and the Norfolk Island language. Witness a woodturning demonstration using Norfolk timber and visit an island home and learn about

traditional cooking. Afternoon tea will be served on this tour. The Progressive Dinner is our last dinner together as a group. Enjoy a 3-course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night, and a great way to meet local people.

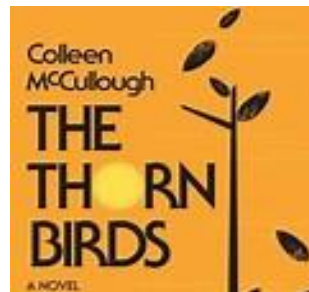
